THE NC STATE ARCHIVES IS EXHIBITING THE ORIGINAL NORTH CAROLINA COPY OF THE 19TH AMENDMENT AT TWELVE SITES ACROSS THE STATE BETWEEN NOVEMBER 6, 2019 AND NOVEMBER 28, 2020. A CHAPTER OF THE LEAGUE OF WOMEN VOTERS WILL BE PRESENT AT EACH OF THESE EXHIBITS TO REGISTER VOTERS. THE FOUR PIEDMONT SITES ARE:

MARCH 6, 2020 - ALAMANCE COMMUNITY COLLEGE, 8:30 – 2:00, SPONSORED BY THE SOCIAL AND BEHAVIORAL SCIENCE DEPARTMENT, this event, primarily for middle school students will have a variety of activities related to suffrage and civics education. There will be an election for a “Suffrage President” with Wonder Woman and Captain Marvel campaigning in costume all day. A voting experience will be created using an “official” booth and those who vote will receive an “I Voted” sticker. Approximately 1,000 students are expected to attend.
