

## **Contact information from the LWVPT program on DACA and immigration, September 19, 2017**

Contact your federal representatives. Ask them to support DACA recipients, who are contributing to our economy and even serving in the military. Oppose the administration's authorizing Immigrations and Customs enforcement to make arrests and deport immigrants without serious criminal records. Point out that in North Carolina, undocumented immigrants pay an estimated \$277 million per year in state and local taxes, and that granting legal status to all undocumented immigrants in North Carolina as part of comprehensive immigration reform and allowing them to work legally would increase their state and local tax contributions: North Carolina would see revenue increase of over \$93 million.
